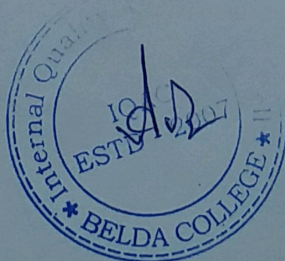

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT BASED ON FEEDBACK COLLECTED FOR THE SESSION 2019-20




